The City Council of the City of Mobile, Alabama, met in the Auditorium of the Mobile Government Plaza on Tuesday, June 12, 2018, at 10:30 a.m., in regular meeting.

The meeting was called to order by City Clerk Lisa Lambert.

Reverend W. A. James, Pastor, Grace and Truth Christian Fellowship Church, offered an invocation.

STATEMENT OF RULES BY COUNCIL VICE PRESIDENT:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MOBILE ON THE 16TH DAY OF MAY, 1967, SAID ORDINANCE BEING COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOBILE AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That the Ordinance commonly known as the Zoning Ordinance and adopted on May 16, 1967, together with the Zoning Map of the City of Mobile, 1967, be, and the same hereby is changed and altered in respect to that certain property in the City of Mobile, State of Alabama, described as follows to-wit:

LOTS 1 AND 2, HILLCREST COMMONS PHASE TWO, RESUBDIVISION OF AND ADDITION TO LOT 1 AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 121 PAGE 37, PROBATE COURT RECORDS, MOBILE COUTNY, ALABAMA, AND LOTS 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 AND 12, BLOCK 80, PINEHURST, DELANY'S ADDITION TO SPRINGHILL AS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 138 PAGES 118-122 OF THE AFORESAID RECORDS, AND THE NORTH HALF OF DUNCAN STREET THAT ADJOINS BLOCK 80, PINEHURST, DELANY'S ADDITION TO SPRINGHILL AS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 138

The classification of said property is hereby changed from R-1, Single-Family Residential District, B-1, Buffer Business District, and B-2, Neighborhood Business District, to B-1, Buffer Business District, and it shall hereafter be lawful to construct on such property any structures permitted by the Ordinance of May 16, 1967, commonly known as the Zoning Ordinance and to use said premises for any use permitted by the terms of said Ordinance in a B-1, Buffer Business District, provided, however, that the plans for any structure or building sought to be erected on said property shall be in compliance with the building laws of the City of Mobile, and that any structure shall be approved by the Building Inspector of the City of Mobile, and that any such structure be erected only in compliance with such laws, including the requirements of said Zoning Ordinance of May 16, 1967, and further provided, however, that no lot or parcel of land herein above described shall be used for any use allowed in a B-1, Buffer Business District, until all of the conditions set forth below have been complied with: 1) Completion of the Subdivision

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process; 2) Limited to an approved Planned Unit Development; and 3) Full compliance with all municipal codes and ordinances.

Section Two; This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.

The ordinance was read by the City Clerk; whereupon Councilmember Rich moved that the ordinance be adopted, which was seconded by Councilmember Daves.

Councilmember Rich stated for the record:

"Chandler Street is a narrow street and basically unimproved. It does not have proper curbing, gutters or sidewalks. I know that you will have to meet code in the development according to the ordinance. I appreciate that everything will be zoned B-1 for this parking lot. What it's adding is 104 additional parking spaces. I had asked some questions at the Planning Commission because my office gets calls about the narrow egress and ingress from Chandler onto Hillcrest. It is my understanding that there is no access from Chandler to this parking. Is that correct?"

Jerry Byrd, speaking on behalf of the applicant:

"Not into the additional parking no."
